" Within the framework of mobility project, we have carried out studies to assess

the status of sleep quality and analyze the factors affecting the sleep quality of Vietnamese people during the COVID-19 period.

Sleep impairment is becoming more and more common not only in Vietnam but also around the world, seriously affecting work performance, causing great damage in terms of economy and health. Therefore, it is essential to evaluate sleep quality and influencing factors, especially in the context of the global Covid-19 pandemic in the past 2 years, increasing instability in mental health, sleep quality and life quality ".
